- 1965** GINO development in SAL begins at Cambridge University
- 1968** CADCentre set up by Dept. of Trade & Industry
- 1972** Fortran GINO development begins
- 1973** GINO-F Mark I released
- 1974** BRADLY ASSOCIATES established as support agent
- 1975** GINO-C (Corel-66) development begins at Bradly Associates
- 1977** GINO User Group formed
- 1980** 1st installation on DEC VAX
- 1984** GINO available on 8-bit micros
- 1988** Bradly Associates buys full rights of GINO from CADC
- 1990** GINO available with 32-bit PC compilers
- 1993** GINOMENU Fortran programmable GUI released
- 1994** GINO available under MS Windows
- 1995** GINO-C (C/C++) released
- 1997** Fortran-90 version released
- 1999** GINOMENU Studio (Fortran GUI builder) released
- 2003** VB, Delphi and .NET versions released
- 2005** GINO's 40th Anniversary
